



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
RAJAMANGALA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY SUVARNABHUMI (RMUTSB)
AND
YUNNAN COLLEGE OF BUSINESS AND MANAGEMENT

IN ORDER to promote co-operation between the Rajamangala University of Technology Suvarnabhumi and Yunnan College of Business and Management, the following memorandum of understanding has been agreed :

To the extent feasible, both Universities will encourage direct contact and co-operation between their faculty members, departments, and schools.

The two Universities will endeavor to co-operate on education and research areas of mutual interest.

Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of co-operation will be pursued :

1. Student exchange programs
2. Faculty/staff exchange programs
3. Cultural exchange programs
4. Cooperative degree programs

Themes of joint activities and the most appropriate way of utilizing the results achieved, arrangement for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of co-operation will be developed mutually in each specific instance. Agreement entered into by Rajamangala University of Technology Suvarnabhumi may be subject to review and approval by the Thai Ministry of Education.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

HEREUPON the signatures of the representative of both University will follow in the hope of promoting mutual friendship and co-operation. The agreement will remain in effect until one part notifies the other of its wish to terminate the agreement at least ninety (90) days before the end of the academic year.
