MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(“MOU”)

RECITALS

- (A) RMUTSB is a group of Universities, that has 4 campuses in Thailand.
- (B) CompTIA is an organization advancing the global interests of IT professionals and companies, and offers vendor neutral IT certifications globally.

UNDERSTANDING

1. Purpose of this MoU

- 1.1 This MoU contains preliminary, non-binding terms and conditions upon which the Parties intend to establish a cooperative relationship and commence negotiations towards the execution of a definitive agreement.
- 1.2 The parties acknowledge and agree that the respective rights and obligations of the Parties remain to be defined in an agreement or series of agreements which shall supersede this MoU and all other communications between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.

2. Intended Activities

- 2.1 Availability of CompTIA A+ certification exams in Thai language before 31st December, 2012.
- 2.2 RMUTSB to include CompTIA A+ training and certification program into their Bachelor Degree program of University for which the students will need to sit for their CompTIA A+ certification after training is completed.
- 2.3 CompTIA to provide special academic program pricing to RMUTSB as CAPP Academy Partner.
- 2.4 RMUTSB to establish a CompTIA Service Center and Lab room for the internship program of RMUTSB students and others taking their CompTIA Certification to gain practical experiences after being certified on CompTIA A+. Subject to execution of a license agreement, CompTIA will authorize RMUTSB to use CompTIA logo in the center in according to CompTIA global standards and guidelines. CompTIA to certify the Service Center and Lab Room in accordance with CompTIA ASC (Authorized Service Center) requirements.

- 2.5 RMUTSB to establish a CompTIA training facility and CompTIA to co-operate with RMUTSB to provide Train-the-Trainer classes for instructors certification on CompTIA A+ to Academic institutions in Thailand.
- 2.6 RMUTSB and CompTIA to have joint promotion and marketing program, including seminars and articles in academic papers and brochure in RMUTSB to promote CompTIA certifications into the Bachelor degree programs in RMUTSB.
- 2.7 RMUTSB and CompTIA to also jointly promote and market CompTIA training and certification program to other government universities, private universities and academic institutions in Thailand.

3. General

3.1 Relationship

Nothing in this MoU constitutes or is to be construed to constitute a party as the partner, agent, employee or representative of the other party. A party shall act independently of the other party and does not have the right or power to commit the other party on any matter or incur any obligations on behalf of or pledge the credit of the other party without the prior written approval of the other party.

3.2 Costs and Expenses

3.2.1 Each party must bear its own costs and expenses (including but not limited to legal costs) incurred in respect of the negotiations, preparation and execution of this MoU.

3.2.2 All costs and expenses incurred thereafter in respect of negotiations, preparation and execution of agreement(s) between the parties shall be discussed and confirmed between each party beforehand.

3.3 Press Announcement

Neither party shall be entitled to make or permit or authorize the making of any press release or other public statement or disclosure concerning this MoU or any of the transactions contemplated in it without the prior consent of the other party.

3.4 Legality

This MoU does not have any legal effect and represents only a good faith understanding between the parties.

4. Good Faith

In executing this MoU, the parties recognize that it is impractical to make provisions for every aspect of the proposed collaboration contemplated herein and agree to act in good faith in connection with the stated goals and objectives of this MoU in working towards a definitive agreement.

5. Intellectual Property Rights

Neither Party nor any of its subsidiaries or associate companies thereof shall have any right to the use of any patents, registered designs, copyright, trade marks or other industrial or intellectual property right of the other party or any of their subsidiaries or associate companies except as may be specifically agreed upon in writing between the parties. No license or any other right to use the other parties' intellectual property is stated or inferred in this MoU.


